

# Reporting Shropshire's Rookeries 2025

## Background

Thank you for your interest and hopefully help in field reporting Shropshire Rookeries 2025.

All Shropshire's known rookery sites in 2020 are mapped on the report page, where you can zoom in. Each Site has a "Pin" starting **White**, **Grey** or **Black**

During the Survey Phases the Pins will change to **Yellow** then **Orange** and finally to **Green**.

A **Grey** or **Black Pin** indicates a site unoccupied in 2020 – though you may find it alive. In that case please report it.

Please read the text (right) before you start entering your information.

## Guidance

The three **Rookery Survey Phases** are colour coded:

**Phase 1 – Yellow** : Socialising (to 31 January)

**Phase 2 – Orange** : Building through nestling (February & March)

**Phase 3 – Green** : Nest counting (April)

All Pins at 31 April 2025 should finally be:

**Green**, occupied or  
**Black**, confirmed **Dead**.

**Don't report** a Site already reported in the Current Phase.

### Pin Positions:

The location of **Pins** may not be accurate. You can refine the mapped location by clicking the box 'Change Location' beneath the site's map and refine the location. The Site position is the point of the **Purple Balloon**.

■ Read the text at the top of the input page before looking at the map and your site's Pin.

■ In the red-bounded box, select your appropriate action:  
**Existing Site** *signs of activity* or  
**New Site** at a *previously unrecorded* Site.

### ■ Reporting an existing known Site.

Zoom in on the map to your site's location using the mouse or equivalent. Smartphones automatically position you on the map.

Click on your chosen Site to complete the data request. Location and Elevation will be detected and entered automatically.

**If you see a Grey or Black Pin** at your Rookery Site it indicates a Site thought to be Dead.

If you find it active, please report it alive in the comments box. **Admin** will change the Pin Colour as appropriate.
